COLAs Don't Count Act of 2026

This bill revises requirements for determining eligibility and benefits under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) to exclude income received from certain (1) cost-of-living adjustments under the Social Security Act and to railroad retirement and veterans' benefits, and (2) supplementary payments under the Social Security Act.

Actions Timeline

- **May 20, 2026:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Nutrition and Foreign Agriculture.
- **Jan 8, 2026:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 8, 2026:** Referred to the House Committee on Agriculture.
