## **Small Business Procurement and Utilization Reform Act of 2025 or the SPUR Act**

This bill requires federal agencies to include on their annual scorecard for small business contracting the number of small businesses that receive a prime contract for the first time and are owned and controlled by service-disabled veterans, qualified HUBZone small business concerns, small business concerns owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals, or small business concerns owned and controlled by women.

- **Feb 24, 2025:** Mr. Williams (TX) moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.

- **Feb 24, 2025:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 818.
- **Feb 24, 2025:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
