A Representative from Louisiana. Born in Quitman, Jackson Parish, La. , December 5, 1946. Graduated from Jonesboro-Hodge High School, Jonesboro, La. , 1964. Graduated, University of Louisiana-Monroe, Monroe, La. United States Air Force reserve, 1965-1971. Insurance agent. Businessman. Member of the Louisiana state house of representatives, 1987-2002. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Eighth Congress. Changed party affiliation from a Democrat to a Republican on August 9, 2004, elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Ninth and to the four succeeding Congresses until his resignation on September 27, 2013 (January 3, 2003- September 27, 2013).
