A Representative from Georgia. Born in Iowa City, Johnson County, Iowa, November 5, 1948. Graduated, Community High School, Tehran, Iran, 1966. B. A. , University of Southern California, Los Angeles, Calif. , 1970. M. A. , George Washington University, Washington, D. C. , 1972. J. D. , Georgetown University Law Center, Washington, D. C. , 1977. Central Intelligence Agency, 1970-1978. United States Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia, 1986-1990. Anti-drug coordinator for Department of Justice, Southeastern United States, 1986-1990. Head, Public Corruption Subcommittee for United States Attorney General, 1987-1988. President, Southeastern Legal Foundation, 1990-1991. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the United States Senate in 1992. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourth and to the three succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1995-January 3, 2003). One of the managers appointed by the House of Representatives in 1998 to conduct the impeachment proceedings of President William Jefferson Clinton. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Eighth Congress in 2002. Unsuccessful Libertarian Party candidate for election for President of the United States in 2008. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Fourteenth Congress in 2014.
