Urban planner, United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, 1965-1966. Division director, Nebraska Department of Economic Development, 1967-1968. Director, Office of Planning and Programming, Nebr. , 1968-1970. Federal-State Relations Coordinator for Nebraska state government, 1967-1970. Member of the Nebraska Crime Commission, 1969-1971. Member of the Nebraska unicameral legislative, 1975-1978. Elected as a Republican to the Ninety-sixth and to the twelve succeeding Congresses and served until his resignation on August 31, 2004 (January 3, 1979-August 31, 2004).
