A. , Willamette University, Salem, Oreg. , 1968. J. D. , Willamette University, 1971. Admitted to the California bar, 1971, and commenced practice in San Rafael. Director, Department of Human Relations, Marin County, Calif. , 1973. Executive director, Marin County Housing Authority, 1974. Elected, California legislature, 1979-1982. Delegate, California State Democratic convention, 1982. Delegate, Democratic National Convention, 1980. Elected as a Democrat to the Ninety-eighth and to the three succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1983-January 3, 1991). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection in 1990 to the One Hundred Second Congress. Is a resident of Occidental, Calif.
