A Representative from Virginia. Born in Washington County, Va. , August 1, 1946. Graduated from Abingdon High School, Abingdon, Va. , 1964. B. A. , Roanoke College, Salem, Va. , 1968. J. D. , University of Virginia School of Law, Charlottesville, Va. , 1971. Lawyer, private practice. Member of the Virginia state senate, 1974-1983. Elected as a Democrat to the Ninety-eighth and to the thirteen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1983-January 3, 2011). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Twelfth Congress in 2010.
