A Representative from North Carolina. Born in Windsor, Bertie County, N. C. , February 15, 1942. Graduated from W. S. Etheridge High School, Windsor, N C. , 1959. B. S. , North Carolina Central University, Durham, N. C. , 1963. North Carolina Central Law School, Durham, N. C. , 1965. North Carolina Army National Guard, 1968. North Carolina Army National Guard Reserve, 1968-1971. Lawyer, private practice. Librarian. Professor, South Carolina State College, Orangeburg, S. C. , 1965-1966. Member of the North Carolina state house of representatives, 1982-1985. Member of the North Carolina state senate, 1989-2002. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Eighth Congress and served until resignation June 11, 2004 (January 3, 2003- June 11, 2004). Died on February 22, 2019, in Raleigh, N. C.
