A Delegate from Guam. Born in Graceville, Big Stone County, Minn. , May 31, 1933. Graduated from George Washington High School, Mangilao, Guam, 1951. Attended St. Mary's College, South Bend, Ind. Attended, St. Katherine's College, St. Paul, Minn. , 1953. Member of the Guam legislature, 1981-1982, 1987-1994. Unsuccessful candidate for Governor of Guam in 1990. Lieutenant governor of Guam, 1995-2002. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Eighth and to the seven succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2003-January 3, 2019). Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress in 2018.
