### Biography

A Senator from Massachusetts. Born on September 12, 1959, in Kittery, Maine. Graduated Wakefield High School, Wakefield, Mass. , 1977. B. A. , Tufts University, 1981. J. D. , Boston College Law School, 1985. Massachusetts Army National Guard 1979-2014, attaining the rank of colonel, and serving in the Judge Advocate Generals Corps. Lawyer, private practice. Wrentham, Mass. , selectman 1995-1998. Member of the Massachusetts state house of representatives 1999-2004. Member of the Massachusetts state senate 2004-2010. Elected as a Republican to the United States Senate in a special election on January 19, 2010, to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Edward M. Kennedy, a seat subsequently held by appointed senator Paul G. Kirk, took the oath of office on February 4, 2010, and served from February 4, 2010, to January 3, 2013. Unsuccessful candidate for reelection in 2012. Moved to New Hampshire, and was an unsuccessful candidate for election to the United States Senate from that state in 2014.
