A Representative from Alabama. Born in Charleston, Charleston County, S. C. , April 29, 1954. Graduated from Grissom High School, Huntsville, Ala. , 1972. B. A. , Duke University, Durham, N. C. , 1975. J. D. , University of Alabama School of Law, Tuscaloosa, Ala. , 1978. Lawyer, private practice. Tuscaloosa County, Ala. , prosecutor, 1978-1980. Law clerk, presiding Circuit Court Judge John Snodgrass, 1980-1982. Member of the Alabama state house of representatives, 1982-1991. Madison County, Ala. , district attorney, 1991-1992. Special assistant attorney general, state of Alabama, 1995-2002. Commissioner, Madison County, Ala. , commission, 1996-2011. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Twelfth and to the five succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2011-January 3, 2023). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Eighteenth Congress in 2022, but was an unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the United States Senate.
