Business owner. Member of the Michigan state house of representatives, 1999-2002. Member of the Michigan state senate, 2003-2010, majority leader, 2007-2010. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination for Michigan state attorney general, 2010. Unsuccessful candidate for election as Oakland County, Mich. , prosecutor, 2012. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourteenth and to the succeeding Congress (January 3, 2015-January 3, 2019). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress in 2018.
