Assistant to Mayor Terry Goddard of Phoenix, 1984. Member and chair, Phoenix Board of Adjustment, 1989-1992. Director, Arizona Community Service Legal Assistance Foundation, 1986-1990. Practiced business and real estate law in Phoenix. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Third Congress (January 3, 1993-January 3, 1995). Was not a candidate for reelection in 1994, but was an unsuccessful candidate for election to the United States Senate.
