Graduate assistant, University of Oklahoma, Norman, Okla. Faculty, Oklahoma Baptist University, Shawnee, Okla. Staff, United States Representative Marvin (Mickey) Edwards of Oklahoma, 1982-1984. Chairman, Oklahoma Republican Party, 1985-1989. Private advocate. Member of the Oklahoma state senate, 1988-1991. Executive director, National Republican Congressional Committee, 1991-1993. Oklahoma secretary of state, 1995-1999. Chief of staff, Republican National Committee, 1999-2001.
