Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Twelfth Congress, by special election, to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of United States Representative Thaddeus George McCotter (November 6, 2012–January 3, 2013). Was not a candidate for election to the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress in 2012. Died on September 23, 2024.
