A Representative from New York. Born in Schenectady, Schenectady County, N. Y., May 20, 1950. B. S., North Carolina State University, Raleigh, N. C., 1972. M. B. A., University of Alabama, Birmingham, Ala., 1975. Businessman. Erie County, N. Y. Executive, 2007-2011. Unsuccessful candidate for election to the One Hundred Sixth Congress in 1998. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress and to the three succeeding Congresses until his resignation on September 30, 2019 (January 3, 2013-September 30, 2019). Convicted on January 16, 2020, of conspiracy and making false statements. Full pardon granted by President Donald J. Trump on December 22, 2020.
