A. , Xavier University, New Orleans, La. , 1986. Attended Carnegie Mellon University, Pittsburgh, Pa. Entrepreneur. Business consultant. Member of the Louisiana state house of representatives, 1992-1994. Member of the New Orleans, La. , city council, 1994-2002. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination for Mayor of New Orleans, La. , in 2002. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Tenth Congress in 2006. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Eleventh Congress in 2008. Member of the Louisiana state senate, 2016-2021. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Seventeenth Congress, by special election, to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of United States Representative Cedric Richmond, and reelected to the two succeeding Congresses (April 24, 2021-present).
