Biography

A Representative from Texas. Born in Mercedes, Hidalgo County, Tex., September 22, 1927. Educated at Mission (Tex.) High School, Edinburgh (Tex.) Junior College, and St. Mary's University, San Antonio, Tex., LL. B., 1952. At age 17 enlisted in the United States Navy and served from 1945 to 1946. Served as an officer in the United States Army, Thirty-seventh Division Artillery, 1950-1952. Graduated as a second lieutenant, St. Mary's ROTC, in 1951 and from the Artillery School, Fort Sill, Okla., in 1952. Was admitted to the bar in 1952 and began practice in Mission, Tex. Member of the Texas state house of representatives 1952-1964. Elected as a Democrat to the Eighty-ninth and to the fifteen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1965-January 3, 1997). Chair, Committee on Agriculture (Ninety-seventh through One Hundred Third Congresses). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Fifth Congress. Died on March 13, 2017, in McAllen, Tex.
