S. , University of Houston, Houston, Tex. , 1970. Business owner. Member of the Texas state house of representatives, 1979-1984. Elected as a Republican to the Ninety-ninth and to the ten succeeding Congresses until his resignation on June 9, 2006 (January 3, 1985-June 9, 2006). Majority whip (One Hundred Fourth through One Hundred Seventh Congresses). Majority leader (One Hundred Eighth and One Hundred Ninth Congresses).
