A Representative from Washington. Born in Bremerton, Kitsap County, Wash. , December 16, 1940. Graduated from West Bremerton High School, Bremerton, Wash. , 1959. B. A. , University of Washington, Seattle, Wash. , 1963. J. D. , University of Washington School of Law, Seattle, Wash. , 1968. Lawyer, private practice. Staff, United States Senator Warren G. Magnuson of Washington, 1968-1976. Elected as a Democrat to the Ninety-fifth and to the seventeen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1977-January 3, 2013). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress in 2012.
