S. , Pennsylvania State University, University Park, Pa. , 1975. Member of the Swissvale, Pa. , borough council, 1977-1981. Staff, Pennsylvania state senator Frank Pecora, 1979-1994. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Fourth and to the thirteen succeeding Congresses until his resignation on December 31, 2022 (January 3, 1995-December 31, 2022). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Eighteenth Congress in 2022.
