A Representative from Maryland. Born in Arbutus, Howard County, Md. , November 25, 1957. B. A. , Princeton University, Princeton, N. J. , 1979. J. D. , Wake Forest University School of Law, Winston-Salem, N. C. , 1982. Member of the Maryland state general assembly, 1987-1994. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourth and to the three succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1995-January 3, 2003). Not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Eighth Congress in 2002. Governor of Maryland, 2003-2007. Unsuccessful candidate for governor of Maryland in 2010.
