A Representative from California. Born in New Britain, Hartford County, Conn. , December 13, 1942. Graduated from New Britain High School, New Britain, Conn. , 1960. A. A. , Canada College, Redwood City, Calif. , 1975. Democratic National Committeewoman from California, 1980-1992. Chief of staff, speaker pro tempore of the California state assembly, 1981-1982. Member of the San Mateo County, Calif. , board of supervisors, 1983-1992, president, 1986. Member, California Democratic state central executive committee. Member of the Democratic National Commission on Presidential Nominations, 1982. Unsuccessful candidate for election to the United States House of Representatives in 1988. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Third and to the fifteen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1993-January 3, 2025). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Nineteenth Congress in 2024.
