Biography

A Representative from Illinois. Born in Chicago, Ill., April 11, 1911. Graduated, Holy Trinity High School. Attended Loyola University. Real Estate School of Illinois, and Midwest Institute. Member of Illinois general assembly, 1955-1975. Elected as a Democrat to the Ninety-fourth Congress by special election, to fill the vacancy caused by the death of United States Representative John Kluczynski and reelected to the three succeeding Congresses (July 8, 1975-January 3, 1983). Unsuccessful candidate for renomination to the Ninety-eighth Congress in 1982. Died in Chicago, Ill., June 7, 1984. Interment at Resurrection Cemetery, Justice, Ill.
