Biography

A Representative from Massachusetts. Born in Bayonne, Hudson County, N. J., March 31, 1940. Graduated from Bayonne High School, Bayonne, N. J., 1957. A. B., Harvard University, Cambridge, Mass., 1962. Graduate work in political science and teaching fellow in government, Harvard University, Cambridge, Mass., 1962-1972. J. D., Harvard Law School, Cambridge, Mass., 1977. Staff, Mayor Kevin White of Boston, Mass., 1968-1971. Staff, United States Representative Michael F. Harrington of Massachusetts, 1971-1972. Member of the Massachusetts state legislature, 1973-1980. Elected as a Democrat to the Ninety-seventh and to the fifteen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1981-January 3, 2013). Reprimanded by the U. S. House of Representatives on July 29, 1990, for improper use of political influence to fix parking tickets and to influence probation officers for a personal friend. Chair, Committee on Financial Services (One Hundred Tenth and One Hundred Eleventh Congresses). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress in 2012.
