Biography

A Representative from Wisconsin. Born in Appleton, Outagamie County, Wis. , May 12, 1932. Attended the public schools. B. B. A. , University of Wisconsin School of Commerce, Madison, Wis. , June 1959. LL. B. , University of Wisconsin Law School, January 1962. Served in the United States Navy, 1951-1955. Admitted to the Wisconsin bar in 1962 and commenced practice in Appleton. Certified public accountant. Real estate broker. State representative, 1963-1973. Assembly Republican caucus chairman, 1965-1967. Assembly speaker, 1967-1971. Assembly minority leader, 1971-1973. Delegate, Wisconsin State Republican conventions, 1957-1981. Delegate, Republican National Convention, 1972 and 1976. Elected as a Republican to the Ninety-third Congress (January 3, 1973-January 3, 1975). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection in 1974 to the Ninety-fourth Congress. Resumed the practice of law. Unsuccessful candidate for election in 1976 to the Ninety-fifth Congress. Appointed as Outagamie County Circuit Judge by the Governor in 1981 and subsequently elected for a six-year term commencing in 1982. Is a resident of Appleton, Wis.
