Y., city council member. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fifth Congress, by special election to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of United States Representative Susan Molinari, reelected to the five succeeding Congresses (November 4, 1997-January 3, 2009). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Eleventh Congress in 2008. Staten Island, N. Y. Borough president, 2022-present.
