S. , Oklahoma State University, Stillwater, Okla. , 1977. Attended, University of Central Oklahoma, Edmond, Okla. , 1979-1981. Member of the Oklahoma state house of representatives, 1990-1994. Oklahoma lieutenant governor, 1995-2007. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Tenth and to the succeeding Congress (January 3, 2007-January 3, 2011). Not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Twelfth Congress in 2010. Governor of Oklahoma, 2011-2019.
