S. , University of Mississippi, Oxford, Miss. , 1973. M. D. , University of Mississippi, Jackson, Miss. , 1976. United States Navy, 1976-1982. Physician. Entrepreneur. Webster Parish, La. , coroner, 1996-2000. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Eleventh and to the three succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2009-January 3, 2017). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Fifteenth Congress in 2016, but was an unsuccessful candidate for election to the United States Senate. Louisiana state treasurer, 2024-present.
