A Representative from Florida. Born in New York, New York County, N. Y., May 16, 1948. Graduated from Great Neck South High School, Great Neck, N. Y., 1966. B. A., Boston University, Boston, Mass., 1970. J. D., Georgetown University, Washington, D. C., 1973. Lawyer, private practice. Member of the Florida state house of representatives, 1986-1992, 1994-2002. Minority leader, 2000-2002. Mayor of West Palm Beach, Fla., 2003-2011. Unsuccessful candidate for election to the One Hundred Third Congress in 1992. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Thirteenth and to the six succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2013-present).
