Delegate, Democratic National Committee, 1984. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Third and to the twelve succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1993-January 3, 2019). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress in 2018.
