### Biography

A Representative and a Senator from Arizona. Born in Chicago, Cook County, Ill. , November 20, 1979. A. B. , Harvard University, Cambridge, Mass. , 2004. United States Marine Corps, 2002-2006. Public affairs consultant, 2007-2008. Delegate, Democratic National Convention, 2008. Member of the Arizona state house of representatives, 2010-2014, assistant minority leader, 2012-2014. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Fourteenth and to the four succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2015-January 3, 2025). Was not a candidate for reelection to the House of Representatives but was elected as a Democrat to the United States Senate in 2024 for the term ending January 3, 2031.
