Grijalva), a Representative from Arizona; born in Tucson, Pima County, Ariz., October 30, 1970; graduated from Pueblo High School, Tucson, Ariz., 1989; B.A., University of Arizona, Tucson, Ariz., 1995; non-profit staff; member of the Tucson, Ariz., unified school board, 2003-2023; member of the Pima County, Ariz. board of supervisors, 2021-2025, chair, 2023-2025; elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Nineteenth Congress, by special election, to fill the vacancy caused by the death of United States Representative Raúl M. Grijalva (September 23, 2025-present).
