A Representative from Georgia. Born in Atlanta, Fulton County, Ga. , April 22, 1960. Graduated from Tucker High School, Tucker, Ga. , 1978. B. A. , Asbury College, Wilmore, Ky. , 1982. M. Div. , Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Fort Worth, Tex. , 1986. D. Min. , Luther Rice University and Seminary, Lithonia, Ga. , 1988. Pastor. Talk radio host. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Twelfth Congress in 2010. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourteenth and to the three succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2015-January 3, 2023). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Eighteenth Congress in 2022, but was an unsuccessful candidate for nomination for Georgia secretary of state.
