A Representative from Arkansas. Born in Little Rock, Pulaski County, Ark. , December 5, 1956. Graduated from Little Rock Catholic High School, Little Rock, Ark. , 1975. B. S. , Vanderbilt University, Nashville, Tenn. , 1979. Banker. Businessman. Staff, United States Senator John Tower and the United States Senate Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs, 1982-1984. Deputy assistant secretary, United States Treasury, 1989-1991. Special assistant to President George H. W. Bush and Executive Secretary of Economic Policy Council, 1991-1993. Senior advisor, Governor Mike Huckabee of Arkansas, 2008. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourteenth and to the five succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2015-present). Chair, Committee on Financial Services (One Hundred Nineteenth Congress).
