Deputy marshal, Lafayette, La. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fifteenth and to the four succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2017-present). One of the managers appointed by the House of Representatives in 2024 to conduct the impeachment proceedings of Alejandro N. Mayorkas, United States Secretary of Homeland Security.
