Attended Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, La. , 1979-1983, 1989-1990. United States Army. Louisiana Army National Guard. Business manager. Deputy sheriff, St. Landry Parish, La. Deputy marshal, Lafayette, La. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fifteenth and to the four succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2017-present). One of the managers appointed by the House of Representatives in 2024 to conduct the impeachment proceedings of Alejandro N. Mayorkas, United States Secretary of Homeland Security.
