Staff attorney, Wyoming state attorney general's office. Delegate, Republican National Convention, 2016, 2020. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination for Governor of Wyoming in 2018. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Eighteenth and to the succeeding Congress (January 3, 2023-present). One of the managers appointed by the House of Representatives in 2024 to conduct the impeachment proceedings of Alejandro N. Mayorkas, United States Secretary of Homeland Security.
