A Representative from Wyoming. Born in Douglas, Converse County, Wyo. , October 18, 1962. Graduated from Lingle-Fort Laramie High School, Lingle, Wyo. , 1981. Attended Casper College, Casper, Wyo. , 1981-1983. B. S. , University of Wyoming, Laramie, Wyo. , 1986. J. D. , University of Wyoming, Laramie, Wyo. , 1989. Judicial clerk, United States Court of Appeals, Tenth Circuit. Lawyer, private practice. Adjunct professor, Central Michigan University, Mount Pleasant, Mich. Staff attorney, Wyoming state attorney general's office. Delegate, Republican National Convention, 2016, 2020. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination for Governor of Wyoming in 2018. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Eighteenth and to the succeeding Congress (January 3, 2023-present). One of the managers appointed by the House of Representatives in 2024 to conduct the impeachment proceedings of Alejandro N. Mayorkas, United States Secretary of Homeland Security.
