A Representative from South Dakota. Born in Chicago, Cook County, Ill., September 13, 1939. B. S., University of South Dakota, Vermillion, S. Dak., 1964. LL. B., University of South Dakota, Vermillion, S. Dak., 1966. United States Marine Corps, 1955-1959. South Dakota state attorney general, 1974-1978. Governor of South Dakota, 1979-1987, 1994-2002. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Eighth Congress and served until resignation on January 20, 2004 (January 3, 2003-January 20, 2004). Died on January 12, 2012, in Sioux Falls, S. Dak. Interment at Black Hills National Cemetery, Sturgis, S. Dak.
