D. , Cumberland School of Law, Samford University, Birmingham, Ala. , 1987. Lawyer, private practice. Businessman. Instructor, Marshall University, Huntington, W. Va. Member of the West Virginia state house of delegates, 1994-1998. Member of the West Virginia state senate, 2002-2014. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourteenth and to the succeeding Congress until his resignation on September 30, 2018 (January 3, 2015-September 30, 2018). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress in 2018, but was an unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the United States Senate. Judge, W.
