Post-graduate studies, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Cambridge, Mass. , 1981. Urban planner, Toledo-Lucas County, Ohio, Plan Commissions, 1969-1975. Director of planning, National Center for Urban Ethnic Affairs, 1975-1977. Assistant director for urban affairs, domestic policy staff, Executive Office of the President, 1977-1979. Elected as a Democrat to the Ninety-eighth and to the twenty-one succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1983-present).
