Biography

A Representative from Michigan. Born in Flint, Genesee County, Mich. , September 16, 1929. Graduated from St. Mary's High School, Flint, Mich. , 1947. B. A. , Sacred Heart Seminary, Detroit, Mich. , 1952. Teacher's certificate, University of Detroit, Detroit, Mich. , 1955. Graduate work, University of Peshawar, Pakistan, 1958-1959. M. A. , University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Mich. , 1961. Teacher. Member, Michigan state house of representatives, 1965-1974. Member, Michigan state senate, 1975-1976. Delegate to Michigan state Democratic conventions, 1956-1977. Delegate to Democratic National Conventions, 1968 and 1984. Elected as a Democrat to the Ninety-fifth and to the seventeen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1977-January 3, 2013). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress in 2012. Died on October 13, 2021.
