Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Third and to the thirteen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1993- January 3, 2021). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Seventeenth Congress in 2020. Chair, Committee on Homeland Security (One Hundred Ninth and One Hundred Twelfth Congresses).
