### Biography

A Representative from Arizona. Born in Evanston, Cook County, Ill. , June 28, 1942. Graduated from United States Capitol Page School, Washington, D. C. , 1960. B. A. , Northwestern University, Evanston, Ill. , 1965. M. B. A. , Stanford University, Stanford, Calif. , 1967. United States Navy, 1967-1969. United States Navy Reserve, 1970-1977. Special assistant to Illinois Governor Richard Ogilvie, 1972-1973. Business executive. Member of the Arizona state senate, 1977-1982. Elected as a Republican to the Ninety-ninth and to the ten succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1985-January 3, 2007). Not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Tenth Congress in 2006. Died on December 3, 2022.
