Staff, United States Representative Donald Rumsfeld of Illinois, 1965-1966. Foreign service officer, United States Department of State, 1968-1969. Special assistant to director, Office of Economic Opportunity, 1969-1970. Member, Delegation to Geneva Disarmament Conference and United Nations General Assembly, 1971-1972. Business executive. United Nations Conference on Natural Resources, 1975. Member, United States Advisory Commission on International Education and Cultural Affairs, 1975. Director, Federal Home Loan Bank Board, 1975-1976. Delegate, Iowa State Republican conventions 1974, 1976. Elected as a Republican to the Ninety-fifth and to the fourteen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1977-January 3, 2007). Chair, Committee on Banking and Financial Services (One Hundred Fourth through One Hundred Sixth Congresses). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Tenth Congress in 2006.
