### Biography

A Representative from California. Born in Long Beach, Los Angeles County, Calif. , September 22, 1946. Attended St. Barnabas School, Long Beach, 1960. Graduated from St. Anthony High School, Long Beach, 1964. A. B. , Notre Dame University, South Bend, Ind. , 1968. Attended University of Southern California Law Center, Los Angeles, 1968-1969. J. D. , Georgetown University Law Center, Washington, D. C. , 1971. Admitted to the California bar in 1972. Lawyer, private practice. Staff for United States Senators George Murphy of California and Bill Brock of Tennessee. Delegate, California State Republican conventions, 1974-1979. Cochairman, National Congressional Council, 1977-1978. Elected as a Republican to the Ninety-sixth and to the four succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1979-January 3, 1989). Was not a candidate for renomination in 1988 to the One Hundred First Congress. Elected California State attorney general in 1990 for the four-year term beginning in January 1991 and reelected in 1994. Unsuccessful candidate for Governor of California in 1998. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Ninth and to the three succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2005-January 3, 2013). Chair, Committee on House Administration (One Hundred Twelfth Congress). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress in 2012.
