Biography

A Senator and a Representative from Wyoming. Born in Cheyenne, Laramie County, Wyo. , September 10, 1954. Graduated from East High School, Cheyenne, Wyo. , 1972. B. S. , University of Wyoming, Laramie, Wyo. , 1976. B. A. , University of Wyoming, 1978. J. D. , University of Wyoming College of Law, Laramie, Wyo. , 1985. Rancher. Lawyer, private practice. Staff, Wyoming Governor Jim Geringer, 1994-1996. Member of Wyoming state house of representatives, 1979-1983, 1985-1993. Member of Wyoming state senate, 1993-1995. Wyoming state treasurer, 1999-2007. Wyoming state lands and investment acting director, 1997-1998. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Eleventh and to the three succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2009-January 3, 2017). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Fifteenth Congress in 2016. Elected as a Republican to the United States Senate in 2020 for the term ending January 3, 2027.
