A Representative from Utah. Born in Brooklyn, Kings County, N. Y. , December 6, 1975. Graduated from Norwalk High School, Norwalk, Conn. B. A. , University of Hartford, West Hartford, Conn. , 1997. Flight attendant. Call center operator. Member of the Saratoga Springs, Utah, city council, 2003-2009. Mayor of Saratoga Springs, Utah, 2010-2013. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourteenth and to the succeeding Congress (January 3, 2015-January 3, 2019). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress in 2018. Died on March 23, 2025, in Saratoga Springs, Utah. Lay in state in the rotunda of the Utah state capitol, Salt Lake City, Utah, April 6, 2025.
