Member of the Connecticut state senate, 1986-1995. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Fifth Congress and to the two succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1997-January 3, 2003). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Eighth Congress in 2002.
